# SEVERE WEATHER & WINTER WEATHER:

Regardless of the season, the MWSL Board does not cancel games due to severe weather or winter weather.

Games will only be canceled under the following circumstances:

- A field manager closes the field
- Referees AT THE FIELD deem conditions are unsafe or unfit for play

## **EXCESSIVE HEAT:**

Regardless of the season, the MWSL Board does not cancel games due to excessive heat.

Teams should take precautions as they see fit (i.e. hydration breaks, shortened halves, additional subs, etc).

## AIR QUALITY:

## The MWSL Board will cancel games due to air quality under the following circumstances:

If the Air Quality Index (AQI) for the region is at 150 or higher at 3pm on gameday, according to <u>airnow.gov</u> (using zip code 55108).

Should the MWSL be alerted of any of the above weather related scenarios, we will...

- Email team managers of affected teams
- Post on social media
- Mark the game as "canceled" on the website, which also triggers a notification of affected players
- .....

# POSTPONEMENT OR FORFEIT PROCEDURES

It is up to individual teams to decide if they want to proceed with a game affected by weather (or any reason). If your team has decided not to play, and the league has not canceled your game, you have the following options...

- Request to reschedule the game (summer and fall season only)
  - You must email info@mwsl.org AND fields@mwsl.org, as well as the opposing team's manager notifying them you'd like to reschedule the game. Opposing team manager emails can be found on the <u>Team Contacts</u> page.
  - Our Fields and Schedule coordinator will work with the teams to determine a new date and field location.
  - Note: games cannot be rescheduled during Winter Sessions because of limited rented field space.
- Declare a forfeit
  - You must email **info@mwsl.org AND fields@mwsl.org**, as well as the opposing team's manager notifying them of the forfeit. The game will not be rescheduled and is recorded as a 2-0 win to the opposing team.

If a team manager fails to reach out to the necessary parties, their team is subject to fines. This gives us a chance to call off referees for the game. It is normal, and expected, for team managers to be in touch with other managers to decide if proceeding with a game is right for them. We do not use other leagues' or organizations' cancellation reports as a basis for MWSL cancellations.
